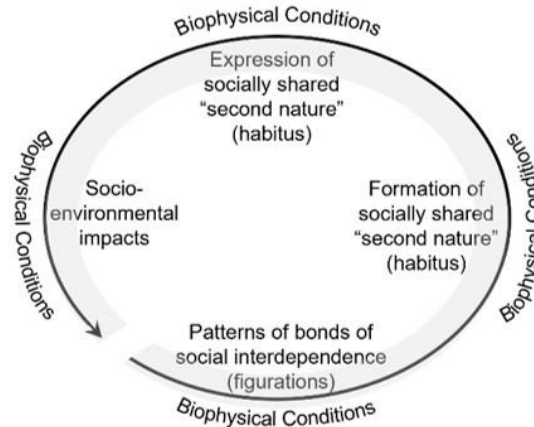
## Consequentiality for Reality

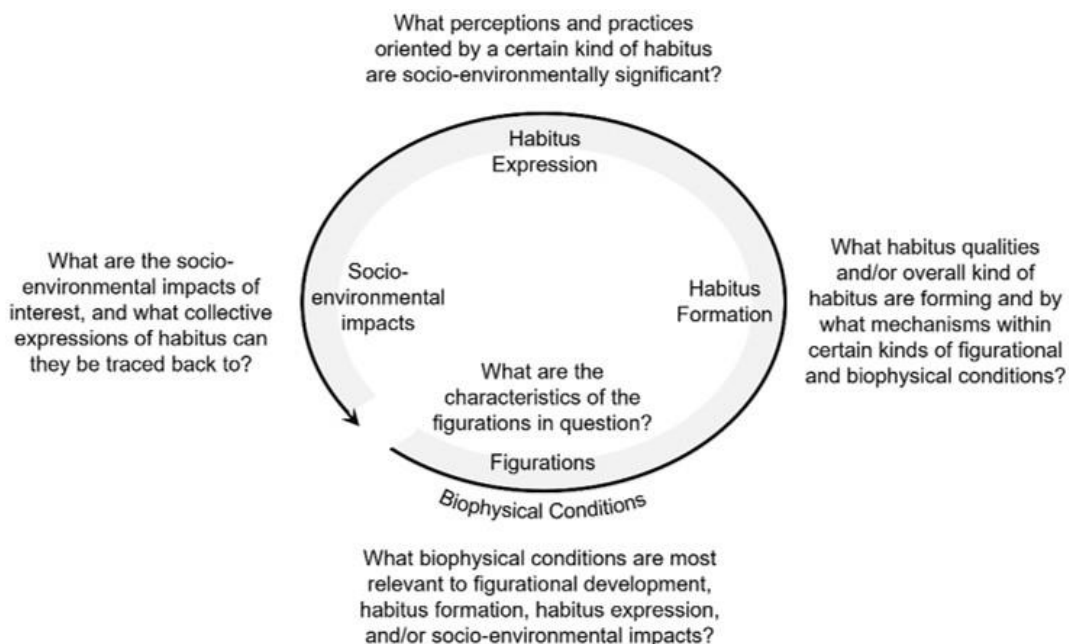
### Purpose

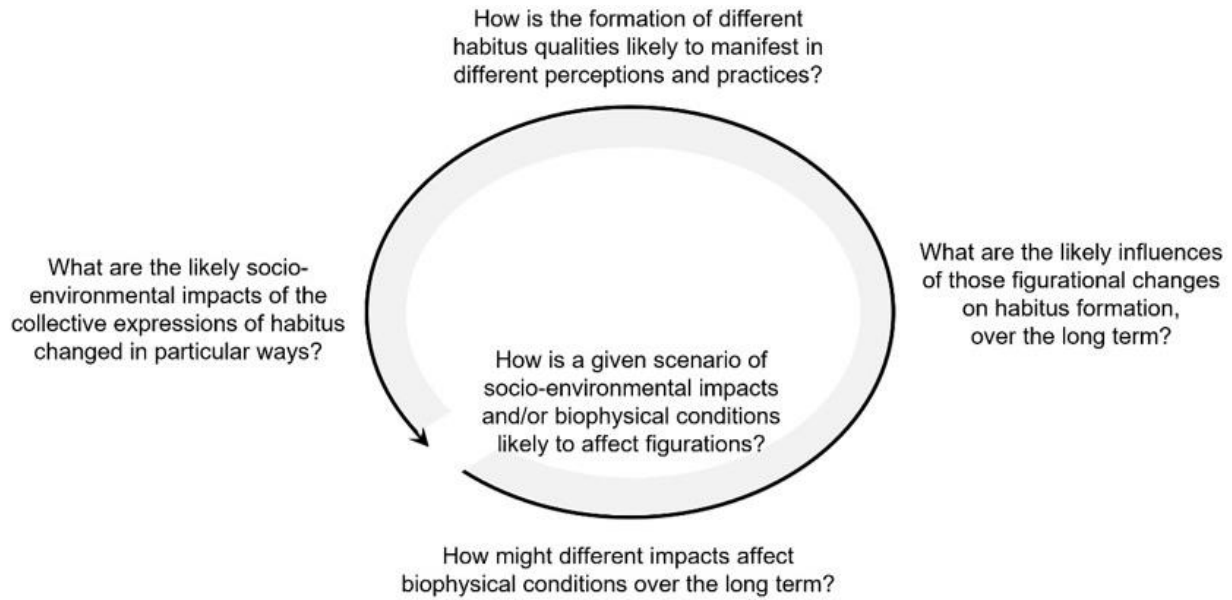
